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**FINAL ORDER**

**THIS MATTER** was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting on October 28, 2014, in Tallahassee, Florida.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. The Commission is charged with hearing appeals of revocations of political committee and political party registrations under Rules 1S-2.021 and 1S-2.050, Florida Administrative Code.
2. Respondent reported no financial activity during the 2013 calendar year and filed Waivers-of-Report for each reporting cycle during the 2013 calendar year.
3. On or about January 15, 2014, Respondent's filing officer issued a Notice of Intent to Revoke registration because the committee's aggregate reported financial activity during the 2013 calendar year was less than \$500.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

4. The Commission has jurisdiction over the parties to and subject matter of this case, pursuant to Section 106.03, Florida Statutes, and Rule 1S-2.021(4), Florida Administrative Code.
5. Respondent did not meet the requirements under Rule 1S-2.021, Florida

Administrative Code, to maintain Respondent's registration as a political committee with the Division of Elections.


**ORDER**

Based on the foregoing facts and conclusions of law, the Commission finds that Respondent did not have at least \$500 in aggregate reported financial activity during the 2013 calendar year.

Therefore, it is

**ORDERED** that the revocation of Respondent's registration as a political committee is upheld.
