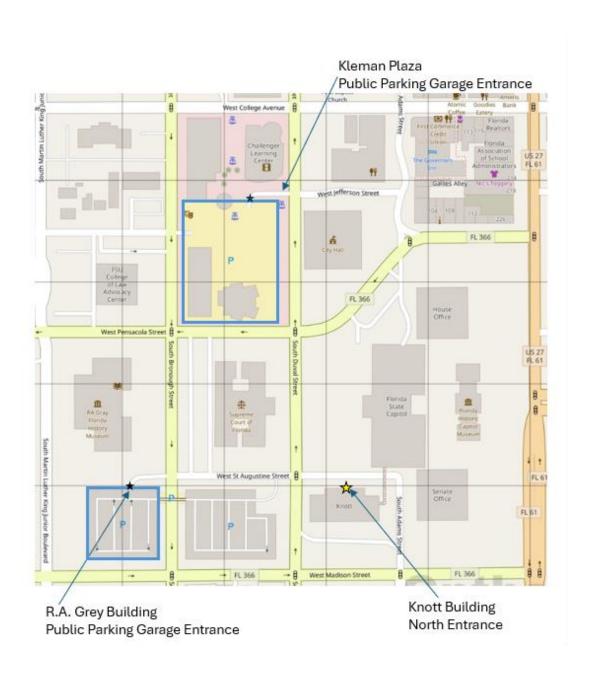

SUMMARY: Metro-Broward Firefighters Political Committee is a political committee (PC) registered with the State of Florida. The PC's chair and treasurer is Brian Powell.

The PC is appealing the fine claiming that the report was timely filed. According to Mr. Powell, the report was filed on July 5th and "subsequently amended on July 20th, 2022, to reflect a Multiple Uniform Contribution automatic bank transfer into the PC account" after a monthly audit. He notes that "MUC transfers into the PC are done automatically"; however, this transfer did not show as completed until after the first submission was made. He requests a waiver of the fine due to the circumstances.

- The 2022 P2 Original Report covers the period from 06/25/22-07/01/22; it was due on 07/08/22.
- The 2022 P2 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created on 06/25/22 and filed on 07/05/22 ¹
- Metro-Broward Firefighters Political Committee reported receiving 1 contribution while making zero expenditures.
- FEC staff was advised, "The committee filed a notice of no activity (waiver) on 07/05/22. A waiver is not a report. On 07/20/22, the committee filed a report showing \$6,488.00 of activity. The fine is based on 25% of the activity."
- The Division of Elections does not have any notes that pertain to Metro-Broward Firefighters Political Committee's 2022 P2 Report.






