NOTICE OF HEARING (AUTOMATIC FINE (AF))

A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on, **August 13, 2024 at 1:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard**, at the following location: **412 Knott Building, Pat Thomas Committee Room, 404 South Monroe Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399**. Due to heightened security access requirements, please bring only essential items into the building and plan to arrive early to allow for delays coming through security.

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

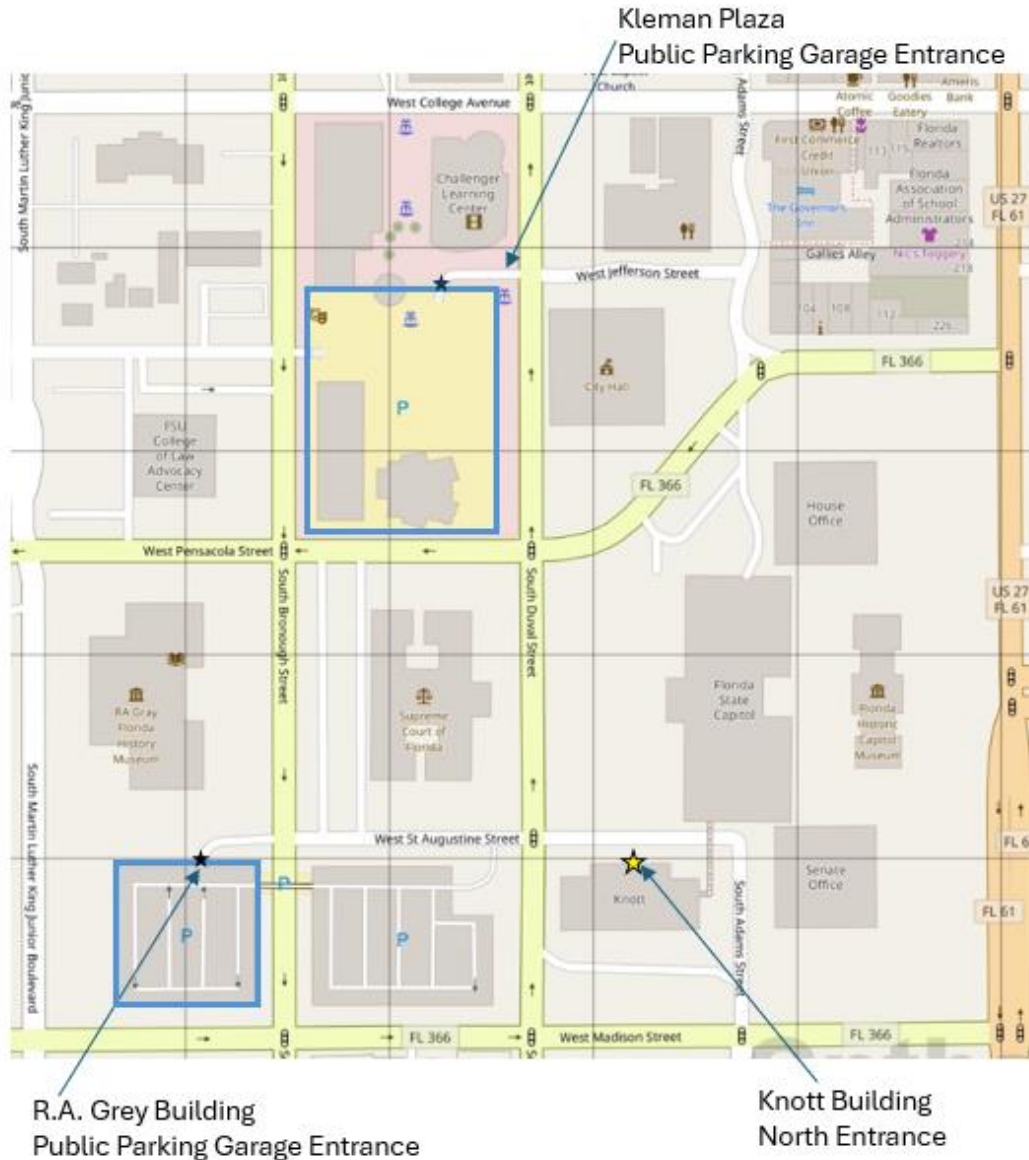
If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: We The People Elect Patriots is a political committee (PC) registered with the State of Florida. The PC's chair and treasurer is Martin Janowiecki.

The PC is appealing the fine claiming that the report was amended to accurately reflect activity found during an audit by the new chairperson and treasurer, Mr. Janowiecki. According to Mr. Janowiecki, his predecessor ceased management of the PC after the 2022 primary election. Upon assuming the new roles, Mr. Janowiecki reviewed the PC's bank account activity and discovered two expenses that occurred several months beforehand. He notes that he contacted the Division of Elections for advice and amended the 2023 M1 and 2023 M2 Reports to reflect that activity. Mr. Janowiecki requests a waiver of the fine due to the circumstances and notes that he amended the reports in good faith.

- The 2023 M2 Original Report covers the period from 02/01/23-02/28/23; it was due on 03/10/23.
- The 2023 M2 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created and filed on 03/01/23.¹
- We The People Elect Patriots reported receiving zero contributions while making 1 expenditure.
- FEC staff was advised, "The committee filed a notice of no activity (waiver) on 03/01/23. A waiver is not a report. On 06/02/23, the committee filed a report showing \$84.99 of activity. The fine is based on 25% of the activity."
- The Division of Elections does not have any notes that pertain to We The People Elect Patriots' 2023 M2 Report.

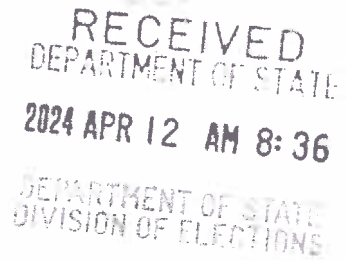

Re: Appeal of late fines related to Treasurer's Reports that were due on Feb. 10, 2023 and March 10, 2023 for We The People Elect Patriots PC, I.D. #80068

Dear Sir or Madam,

I recently received two notices of assessment of late fines in the amounts of \$17.53 and \$21.25 with respect to the Treasurer's Reports that were due for the Political Committee ("PC") on February 10, 2023 and March 10, 2023, respectively (copies attached).

I am writing to respectfully appeal the late fines based on the following facts:

- The election for which this PC was originally formed was the Florida state senate primary election which was held on August 23, 2022. As a result, all activities with respect to the election were completed in 2022
- On May 15, 2023 my appointment as Chairperson and Treasurer for the PC was filed in the office of the Florida Department of State, Bureau of Election Records. The prior Chairperson and Treasurer had ceased to be actively engaged in managing the PC after the 2022 election. However, two expenses were incurred in 2023. The first was a late invoice received in January, 2023 for printing of voter guides in August, 2022. The second was a filing fee for the Federal Form 990 EZ filed with the Internal Revenue Service in February, 2023. Notwithstanding the facts, a waiver for the Treasurer's Reports was filed for these periods.
- Upon assuming the responsibilities of the Chairperson and Treasurer I performed a detailed review of the PC's bank account activity for the period January 1, 2023 through May, 2023. As a result of my review, I discovered that the two expenses mentioned previously had been incurred and funds were paid for those services. In June of 2023 I contacted the Division of Elections to determine the appropriate course of action. As a result, I filed Amended Treasurer's Reports for the periods M1 and M2 of 2023.

Based on the fact that I was not an officer of this PC at the time the late filings were originally due, and the fact that I acted in good faith by filing the Amended Treasurer's Reports to accurately reflect

the expenses of the PC upon assuming the role of Treasurer, I am hereby respectfully appealing the late fines.



Timely Filing

All reports must be completed and filed through the EFS no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the

due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date is subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first three days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the chairperson and campaign treasurer, and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.

Instructions and Assistance

An online instruction guide is available to you on the EFS to assist with navigation, data entry, and submission of reports. The Division of Elections will also provide assistance to all users by contacting the EFS Help Desk at (850) 245-6280.

It is your responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. 
