

ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by <u>consent order</u> where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s) and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.07(2)(b)1.**, **Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on December 4, 2023, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

- 1. On September 6, 2023, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a referral from the Florida Division of Elections ("Complainant" or "Division") alleging that Bruce Hadley Antone ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
- 2. Respondent was a 2022 candidate for State Representative, District 41. (Attachment A, page 1) Respondent was elected. (Attachment B, page 1)
- 3. Respondent's Statement of Candidate form ("DS-DE 84") and Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository form ("DS-DE 9") were filed on June 16, 2022. (ROI Exhibit 1, page 1; Attachment A, page 1)¹ Respondent appointed himself to serve as treasurer for the campaign. (ROI Exhibit 1, page 1)
- 4. By letter dated October 23, 2023, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provision:

Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2022 candidate for State Representative, District 41, acting as his own treasurer, failed to timely make necessary amendments to the 2022 P7 campaign treasurer's report, as alleged in the complaint.

- 5. By letter dated June 21, 2022, Donna S. Brown, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, sent Respondent a letter acknowledging that the Division had received his DS-DE 9 and that his name was placed on the 2022 active candidate list. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 1)
- 6. The acknowledgment letter advised Respondent that all candidates filing reports with the Division are required to use the electronic filing system ("EFS") and provided Respondent with a user identification number and initial password to grant access to the EFS. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 1) The letter further advised Respondent that all the Division's publications and reporting forms were available on its website and directed Respondent to print out Chapter 106, Florida

Statutes, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*, as well as other relevant documents. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 2)

Alleged Violation: Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes

- 7. The campaign's 2022 P7 Report was filed on August 19, 2022. (ROI Exhibit 5, page 6) The report was incomplete when filed as it reflected a petty cash expenditure without an initial petty cash withdrawal. (ROI Exhibit 3, page 2)
- 8. The Division sent three letters notifying Respondent that the campaign's report was incomplete and that Respondent was required to amend the report within seven days of receipt of the notification. (ROI Exhibit 3, pages 1 & 4; ROI Exhibit 4, page 1) An Error Report showing why the report was incomplete was attached to each notification. (ROI Exhibit 3, pages 2, 3, 5 & 6; ROI Exhibit 4, pages 2-3) The final notification was confirmed delivered on July 28, 2023. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 4)
- 9. Respondent stated that he was unaware that the report required amending and was unsure if he had received correspondence from the Division or Commission. (ROI Exhibit 6, page 1)
- 10. As of December 21, 2023, Respondent has not filed the required amendment to the 2022 P7 Report. (Attachment C, page 2)
- 11. Respondent failed to timely amend the campaign's 2022 P7 Report within seven days of receiving notification from the Division.
- 12. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. *Schmitt v. State*, 590 So. 2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. *Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino*, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).
- 13. The facts set forth above show that Respondent was a 2022 candidate for State Representative, District 41. Respondent failed to timely file the required amendment to the campaign's 2022 P7 Report within seven days of receiving notification from the Division that the report was incomplete and required amendment.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find probable cause to charge Respondent with violating the following:

Count 1:

On August 4, 2023, Bruce Hadley Antone violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when he failed to timely file an

addendum to the campaign's 2022 P7 Report within seven days after receiving notice from the Division that the report required amendment.



In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any candidate failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first three days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the candidate and campaign treasurer, and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.

On September 6, 2023, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging that you violated Florida's election laws. I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more **legally sufficient allegations**. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violation:

Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2022 candidate for State Representative, District 41, acting as his own treasurer, failed to timely make necessary amendments to the 2022 P7 campaign treasurer's report, as alleged in the complaint.

When we conclude the investigation, a copy of the Report of Investigation (ROI) will be mailed to you at the above address. Based on the results of the investigation, a staff attorney will prepare and present a written Staff Recommendation (SR) to the Commission as to whether there is probable cause to charge you, the Respondent, with violating Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. You will have an opportunity to respond to both the ROI and the SR. The Commission will then hold one or more hearings to determine whether the alleged violation occurred and, if so, the amount of the fine to be imposed upon you. Notice will be mailed to you and the Complainant at least 14 days before any hearing at which your case is to be considered.

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(i)3., Florida Statutes, the Commission may enter into a consent agreement with a Respondent to settle a complaint prior to a finding of probable cause. If you are interested in entering negotiations directed towards reaching a consent agreement to resolve this matter, please contact the Commission and request to speak with the attorney assigned to this case.
